**P3M WORTH OF SHABU CONFISCATED IN DUMAGUETE CITY**  
**Lady pusher arrested**

Three million worth of methamphetamine hydrochloride, or shabu, was confiscated from a lady pusher by joint anti-narcotics operatives of Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA), Philippine National Police (PNP) and National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) during a buy-bust operation in Dumaguete City on September 21, 2015.

PDEA Director General Undersecretary Arturo G. Cacdac, Jr identified the suspect as Josephine Cabasag y Bantilan, 46 years old, a listed drug personality, and a resident of Crossing Taclobo, Taclobo, Dumaguete City.

At around 5:30 pm, joint operatives of PDEA Regional Office 7 (PDEA RO7) under Director Jeffrey A. Bangsa, Ninoy Aquino International Airport-Interagency Drug Interdiction Task Group (NAIA-IADITG), Negros Occidental Provincial Police Office-Special Operations Group (NOPPO-SOG), Provincial Intelligence Branch, National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), Provincial Anti-Illegal Drugs Special Operations Task Group (PAIDSOTG), Aviation Security Group (AVSEG), Criminal Investigation Detection Group (CIDG), Negros Oriental Provincial Detention and Rehabilitation Center (NOPDRC) and Dumaguete City Police Station conducted a buy-bust operation in Purok Kalubihan, Daro, Dumaguete City which resulted in the arrest of Cabasag after she agreed to sell one piece of heat-sealed transparent plastic sachet suspected to be shabu weighing five grams to a PDEA agent who acted as poseur-buyer.

Confiscated from Cabasag were 28 pieces of heat-sealed transparent plastic sachets suspected to be shabu weighing 300 grams with an estimated value of P3,050,000.00, one sling bag and the two pieces of P500 used as the buy-bust money.

Cabasag now faces charges for violation of the Section 5 (Sale of Dangerous Drugs), and Section 11 (Possession of Dangerous Drugs), Article II of Republic Act 9165, or The Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002.

On the same day, at around 12:50 pm, joint elements of PDEA Regional Office 7-Bohol Provincial Office and Dauis Police Station conducted a buy-bust operation in Brgy. Mariveles, Dauis, Bohol which resulted in the arrest of Roberto Lamberte y Delopiere, alias Ondoy, 34, laborer and a resident of Centro, Tubigon, Bohol.

Seized from Lamberte were two pieces of heat-sealed transparent plastic sachets suspected to be shabu, one rolled aluminum foil, one blade, one disposable lighter and the buy-bust money.

Cases for violation of Sections 5, 11 and 12 (Possession of Equipment and Other Drug Paraphernalia for Dangerous Drugs), Article II of RA9165 will be filed against Lamberte.
